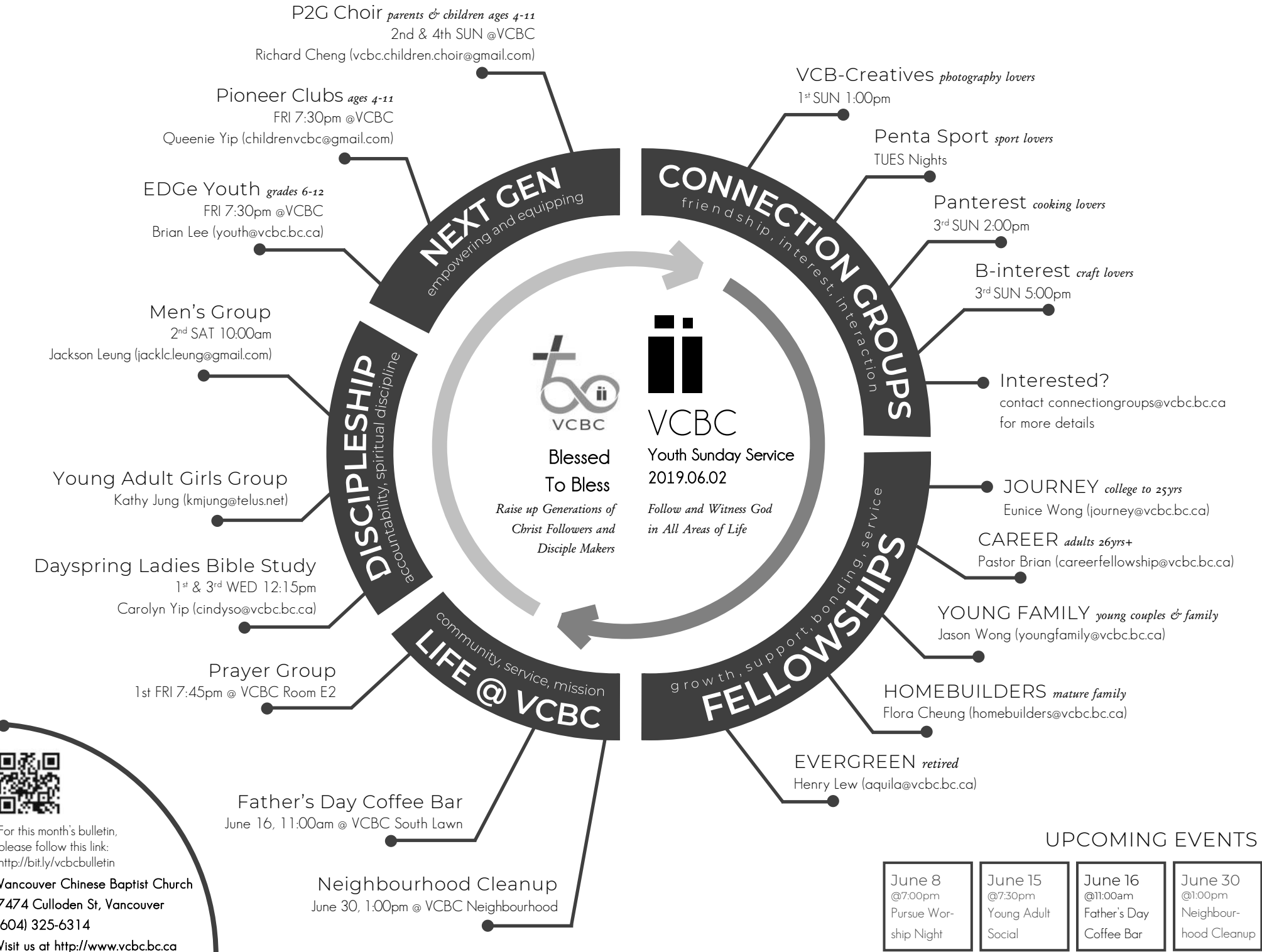

## June 2019: Delight (An Excerpt)

I recently came across a book by J.B. Priestley called "Delight". Priestley wrote it as a legacy to his family in compensation for being such a grumbling "monster". It comprised of short essays about what he found to be the delights in the simple things in life. Priestley's delights included smelling coffee in the morning, listening to chamber music at home and playing charades. The word delight caught my eye, also, when I was going through the Psalms. In Psalm 1:2, the blessed man's "delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night." We are commanded to "Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart." Psalm 37:4. To me, delight seems like an odd word to be used in describing the study of scripture day and night. I normally think of delight as something exquisitely enjoyable, as in the name of a delicacy or the joy of reuniting with friends and family. In fact, the word delight at times does not resonate with my own Christian experience.
